Dermatology

Dermatologists work with skin disorders and ear issues associated with allergies (food, environmental, contact, flea), skin infections (bacterial, fungal, parasitic, atypical), autoimmune skin disease, skin cancer, endocrine diseases of the skin, alopecia, recurrent or non-resolving ear infections, and conditions affecting the nails. Veterinary dermatologists have specialized training in procedures such as video otoscopy, cytology, skin scraping, skin biopsies, fungal and bacterial cultures, and environmental allergy testing via intradermal and serum testing. Specialized intradermal allergy testing is completed on-site, and combining these results with serum allergy testing results, our dermatologist mixes a customized serum called allergen immunotherapy, which is administered by the client via weekly to bi-weekly allergy injection or daily oral drop.
